So some of them are really genuinely afraid of school and need time to get comfortable, and coaches really do help with that.

So far, I have never had a shine coach do anything that I objected to. But I guess I would not want them to talk over me while I'm addressing the class, debate with me about my methods, scold the students, or create a distraction by joking or talking during a time when I am talking or when we need to be quiet. But if I make an error like I miss-spell something on the board or that sort of thing it is totally fine if the shine coach points it out. Sometimes when I'm teaching I don't keep track of everything and someone points out mistakes, and that is fine.
